- Try to use more formal linking words such as however, therefore, as a result, and consequently
- Be careful with capitalization in proper nouns and software names.
- Use more natural collocation (e.g., speak English, experience cultures, Oracle tools).

The student was able to communicate basic ideas, but frequent pronunciation difficulties made comprehension challenging. There were persistent errors with verb tenses and sentence structure, and vocabulary was often limited or repetitive. Greater accuracy with grammatical forms, especially past and present tenses, and a wider range of vocabulary are needed to communicate more effectively.
